## What does a Page do?

Pages work as part of a team to provide assistance to Members, Officers and staff of the Legislative Assembly by

- delivering messages
- distributing documents
- supporting ceremonies and special events
- participating in developmental seminars and a speech competition

## How much does it pay?

Page \$12.50/hour  
Speaker's Page \$13.50/hour  
Head Page \$14.50/hour

## Who can become a Page?

You can apply if you are

- at least 15 years of age
- a full-time high school student
- reliable
- maintaining strong and consistent grades
- a strong communicator with good interpersonal skills

Prior work experience as well as involvement with sports, music, community or volunteer groups is an asset.

Before applying, discuss the program with your parents and school counsellor because the hours of work may affect your class schedule and extracurricular activities.

## What are the hours?

Pages are generally employed during the fall and spring sessions of the Legislative Assembly. Session dates will vary.

Pages are typically scheduled to work up to two to three shifts per week, working mostly afternoon shifts and occasional evening shifts.

Afternoon shifts begin at 12:45 p.m. Monday to Thursday.
