EDUCATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE

APPLICATION INFORMATION

A total of six educators representing all regions of the province are appointed to the committee for two to four year terms. In addition, the committee includes one member with interpretation expertise, one technology consultant and one curriculum consultant. Candidates must be available to attend two two-day meetings annually, held at the Legislature Building in Edmonton. Additional commitments may include assistance with teacher professional development activities.

Each year, a few of the committee members complete their terms and new vacancies are created. Teachers interested in serving on the committee should have experience in Social Studies instruction in Alberta at an elementary, secondary or postsecondary level. In the case of postsecondary it is preferable that the candidate be teaching in a faculty of education. Retired educators are also welcome to apply.

Preference will be given to candidates who have experience in a combination of the following areas:

- curriculum development
- piloting of new initiatives
- delivery of professional development
- involvement in provincial specialist council activities
- mentoring of new teachers or contribution to new teaching initiatives
- development or evaluation of new programming
- experience in outreach programming
- familiarity with school programming offered by the Legislative Assembly of Alberta

There is no remuneration for this appointment; however, approved expenses for attendance at meetings, including substitute teaching expenses, travel and subsistence will be reimbursed by the Legislative Assembly Office.

Interested candidates should submit their curriculum vitae, a covering letter outlining their interest and the names and contact information of three referees who can speak to the professional criteria outlined above.
