The Select Special Committee on Electoral Boundaries (the “Committee”) is seeking self-nominations from interested and qualified individuals for appointment as the Chair of the Independent Advisory Panel (the “Panel”) to be established under Government Motion 37, agreed to by the Legislative Assembly on April 21, 2026, to conduct a review of the electoral boundaries of Alberta and make proposals as to the area, boundaries and names of the electoral divisions of Alberta.

In keeping with Government Motion 37, the Committee is seeking a retired or current judge of the Alberta Court of King’s Bench or the Alberta Court of Appeal or a President of a Post-Secondary Institution in Alberta to chair the Panel in its review. Based on that review, the chair will submit to the Committee a report on or before October 22, 2026.
