Question #2 - Statistics regarding the number of Missing Persons Orders for records sought and the number that are rejected (from committee)

To date CPS has submitted 14 Missing Persons applications. The first application submitted was the only application that was denied.

Question #3 - Statistics regarding the number of missing persons per year and it was possibly requested that we determine how many are “not listed” or not investigated as missing (from committee)

The Calgary Police Service does not record the number of missing persons that are not listed or not investigated as missing. Other than long lost relative cases every person that is recorded as missing is investigated at one of four levels of investigation.

- Chronic Missing Persons (low risk) – Investigated by Patrol Support Team
- Chronic Missing Persons (high risk) – Investigated by Patrol with potential to be forwarded to General Investigative Unit
- Non chronic (low risk) – Investigated by Patrol
- Non chronic (high risk) – Investigated by General Investigative Unit or Missing Persons Team
