At its Friday, November 4, 2016, meeting the Standing Committee on Legislative Offices considered an extension to Ms Jill Clayton's term of office as Information and Privacy Commissioner, which will expire on January 31, 2017.

Section 46 of the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*, excerpted below, provides for the reappointment of the Information and Privacy Commissioner.

## Term of office

- 46(1) Except as provided for in section 47, the Commissioner holds office for a term not exceeding 5 years.
- (2) A person holding office as Commissioner continues to hold office after the expiry of that person's term of office until that person is reappointed, a successor is appointed or a period of 6 months has expired, whichever occurs first.
- (3) A person is eligible for reappointment as Commissioner.
