1.0 INTRODUCTION

Bill 205, *Human Tissue and Organ Donation (Presumed Consent) Amendment Act, 2019*, was introduced and received first reading on November 6, 2019.

2.0 ORDER OF REFERENCE

Pursuant to Standing Order 74.11:

- (1) After a public Bill other than a Government Bill has been read a first time, the Bill stands referred to the Private Bills and Private Members' Public Bills Committee.
- (2) The Private Bills and Private Members' Public Bills Committee shall report back to the Assembly within 8 sitting days of the day on which the Bill was referred to the Committee.

3.0 COMMITTEE ACTIVITIES

As part of the Committee's review of Bill 205, Committee meetings were held on November 18 and 21, 2019. The sponsor of Bill 205, Matt Jones, Member for Calgary-South East, made a presentation on the Bill to the Committee on November 18, 2019, and the Committee received a technical briefing from the Ministry of Health. On November 21, 2019, three stakeholders made oral presentations to the Committee, and the Committee received four written submissions from invited stakeholders (Appendix A). The Committee also received an additional nine written submissions about the Bill.

4.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

Pursuant to Standing Order 74.2 the Standing Committee on Private Bills and Private Members' Public Bills recommends

that Bill 205, Human Tissue and Organ Donation (Presumed Consent) Amendment Act, 2019, proceed.
