- If they want to add more accountability and visibility, they could adopt some of the characteristics of the BC system. Their website is more searchable.
- Highly recommend against moving toward the federal government system, which requires every point of contact (letter or email sent, telephone call, coffee, lunch or dinner, or random meeting to be registered). This would add unnecessary generation of paper and process.
- Recommend against lower the 100 hour minimum
- ascertain with the elected officials whether they have occasion of where the 100 hour minimum is pressed by the same group
- proceed from the basis that the system works well, there is nothing critically wrong
