Subject: Review of the Conflicts of Interest Act - Invitation to make a Written Submission

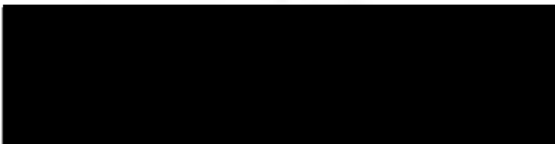
On behalf of Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission, thank you for the opportunity to have our comments considered by Alberta Legislature's Standing Committee on Resource Stewardship as part of their study of *Conflicts of Interest Act*.

Section 12 (e) requires the disclosure of fees, gifts and other benefits accepted having a value greater than \$100. The act does not specify the requirement to accumulate the value of fees, gifts and other benefits received directly or indirectly from one source over the year.

The inclusion of this accumulative value requirement would align with the Office of the Ethics Commissioner requirement to decline tangible gifts exceeding \$200 (in aggregate from the same source in a calendar year).

Thank you for your consideration with your review of the Act.
