Step



The Lieutenant Governor opens the new session by reading the Speech from the Throne.

Step



Candidates campaign for the vote of the people in their constituency.

Step



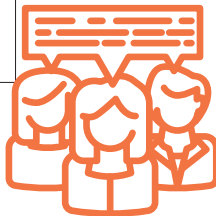
The Legislative Assembly sits for the first time and the Speaker is elected.

Step



Residents of Alberta vote for a candidate in their constituency.

Step



The new Legislature debates and passes laws for Albertans.

Step



The Premier asks the Lieutenant Governor to dissolve the Legislature.

Step



All the members elect are sworn in as MLAs.

Step



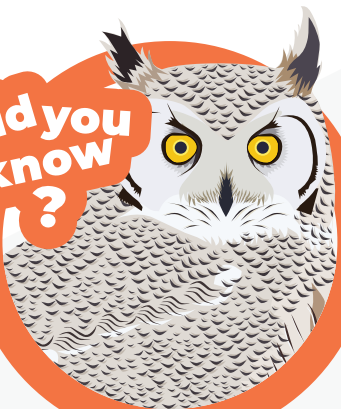
The Lieutenant Governor dissolves the Legislature and orders that there will be an election.

Step



Votes are counted and results are announced. The candidate with the most votes in their constituency becomes a member elect.
