What do Pages do?

Pages work as part of a team to provide assistance to Members, Officers and staff of the Legislative Assembly by

- Delivering messages
- Distributing documents
- Supporting ceremonies and special events

How much do Pages make?

Page: \$15/hour

Training Development Page: \$16/hour

Speaker's Page: \$16/hour **Head Page:** \$17/hour



Who can become a Page?

You can apply if you

- Will be at least 15 years of age by September 1, 2019
- Are entering Grade 10, 11 or 12 as a full-time student
- Maintain strong and consistent grades
- · Are a strong communicator with good interpersonal skills

In addition to strong academics, work experience and involvement with sports, music, and community or volunteer activities are considered assets.

Before applying, discuss the program with your parents and school counsellor because the hours of work may affect your class schedule and extracurricular activities.

What are the hours?

Pages are generally employed during the fall and spring sittings of the Legislative Assembly. Session dates will vary.

During Session the Assembly typically sits Monday to Thursday afternoons, Tuesday to Thursday mornings and may sit some evenings between Monday and Wednesday. While some flexibility in scheduling exists, Pages are expected to work at least three shifts per week.
