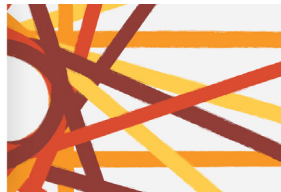

The Borealis Gallery presents a brand new exhibition.

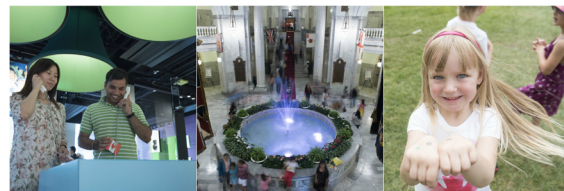
*The Dream We Form By Being Together* centres on the theme of reconciliation and emerges from the awareness that art can play a central role in the process.

On July 1 the Legislature Grounds will be bustling with activity from dawn until dusk.

The **Alberta Family Fun Zone** opens on the Legislature south grounds at 11 a.m. and offers crafts, fun activities and educational and musical performances for parents and children until 5 p.m.



You won't want to miss the **Welcome Ceremony** on the front steps of the Legislature Building at noon. Join CBC Edmonton's Adrienne Pan and Radio-Canada's Rudy Desjardins and some of our province's leaders for the official kickoff to Canada 150 at the Alberta Legislature. Sing *O Canada*, and see a live performance from the Clan MacNaughton Pipe Band.

From there you can head into the **Legislature Building Open House** to explore. Marvel at the building's iconic architecture, and check out where your MLA sits when you walk the Chamber floor.

The **Alberta Discovered Stage**, hosted by CBC Edmonton's Garrette McGowan and Radio-Canada's Marie-Ève DuSablón, will feature some of the best singer-songwriter artists and bands in Alberta from 12:30 to 9 p.m. At 7:35 p.m. this stage will feature special Citizenship Reaffirmation programming presented by national partner, CIBC.

The **Alberta Diversity Stage** will celebrate the richness of our province's cultural landscape through music and dance. Join CBC Edmonton's Adrienne Pan and Radio-Canada's Rudy Desjardins from 1 to 5 p.m. on the Legislature's south band shell.

The Legislature west lawn will feature an **Indigenous Showcase** celebrating the history of Alberta's First Peoples. Immerse yourself in indigenous culture through music and dance performances, storytelling, traditional games, songs and teachings from 1 to 6 p.m.

Canada Day offers a perfect opportunity to check out the **Legislative Assembly Visitor Centre**, open from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. in the Edmonton Federal Building.
